ORDER GRANTING STUDENT CLAIMANTS' MOTION TO APPROVE A DISTRIBUTION PLAN, INCLUDING AN AWARD OF ATTORNEYS' FEES AND EXPENSES, AND STUDENT CLAIMANTS' INCENTIVE AWARDS

Upon the motion² (the "Motion") [Doc. 4561] of Student Claimants for an order pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure ("FRBP") 9014 applying FRBP 7023, having jurisdiction over this Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; it appearing that venue in this Court is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; it appearing that this matter affects the

administration of the debtors' estates; and having heard the representations of counsel for Student Claimants at a hearing on February 16, 2022; after due deliberation thereon, it is hereby ORDERED:

- 1. The Motion is GRANTED:
- 2. The Distribution Plan proposed in the Motion is approved and Student Claimants, working with American Legal Claims Services, are authorized to commence distribution to Class Members under the Distribution Plan;
- 3. The Student Claimants' request for incentive awards from the Common Fund is approved in the amount of \$10,000 per Class Representative;
- 4. The Student Claimants' request for attorneys' fees for the Project on Predatory Student Lending from the Common Fund is approved in the amount of 5% of the total Common Fund; and
- 5. The Student Claimants' request for expenses expended by the Project on Predatory Student Lending from the Common Fund is approved in the amount of \$15,982.40.

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
